Slips trips and falls

The highest number of accidents reported, we see, are for Slip, Trips and Falls. How can slips, trips and falls be prevented?

To achieve a reduction there is a need to understand people's attitudes and perceptions. Managers and employees must be able to understand the causes and consequences of slip, trip and fall accidents.

Near miss reporting procedures should be implemented whenever a slip, trip or fall hazard has been identified. Always review your Risk Assessment after an incident.



Radiation Protection Service Update

Shelley Reid holds the role of Radiation Protection Officer for Shropshire Council and will be your point of contact for the monitoring of radioactive sources at your school and any related queries. Our new Schools Officer, Kevin Jenkins, will be taking on this role later in the year.

You will shortly receive an email to submit an updated CLEAPSS RPA Form 1 for our files.

The completed Form 1's are sent to Simon Wright, RPA at CLEAPSS. They are saved on file as evidence of the procedures and any changes that have taken place in Shropshire Schools.

Audit visits will continue approximately every 2 years, but if you feel that you need any assistance beforehand, please do not hesitate to contact shelley.reid@shropshire.gov.uk

Health & Safety Audit visits

Health and safety audits of schools continue to be carried out

The audit looks at the health and safety management systems within the school to check that there is compliance with health and safety legislation.



The audit also highlights the effectiveness of the Council's health and safety management systems in supporting the school.

It will involve the visiting officer speaking with the Headteacher (and other staff as appropriate) so they can review areas of compliance such as legionella and asbestos management, fire, policies and procedures etc.

The meeting usually lasts 3-4 hours (in primary schools, longer in secondary schools) and gives you the opportunity to ask any other questions about health and safety.

CLEAPSS

CLEAPSS Subscriptions

CLEAPSS subscriptions are now due for

renewal (2024 - 2025)

CLEAPSS is the advisory service providing support in science and technology for a consortium of local authorities and their schools.

<u>Maintained</u> schools receive this service through Shropshire Council.

Secondary schools are required to subscribe to this in order to receive the RPO / RPA service through Shropshire Council. Unless we are informed otherwise, we will continue to subscribe on your behalf and invoice the school for joint subscription and RPO costs (if schools have radioactive sources).

Academy primary schools have the option to buy into this service. The amount you pay is calculated on your pupil numbers at 20p per pupil. Therefore, an annual subscription for a school with 100 pupils would equate to £20.

If you wish to <u>subscribe</u> to this service, please notify the Health and Safety team at <u>health.safety@shropshire.gov.uk</u> by **Wednesday 24th April** and we can arrange this.
